## CLASSROOM SUPPORT

- Light cleaning of classroom(s) after school (one or more days a week for approx. 10-15 minutes, including vacuuming, wiping desks or table tops and cleaning white boards)
- “Room Parent”—coordinates efforts between PTF and teacher and supports teacher with general communication to other parents in a class (i.e. finding field trip drivers, arranging lunch for teachers’ lounge once per year)
- “Party Parent” –consults with teacher to plan and implement class parties
- Classroom assistance—reading to students or breaking students into small groups to read or work on skills assigned by teacher

# TUITION PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM (TPP) AGREEMENT

WCA is committed to making classical, Christian education affordable for families. If full tuition, including the sibling discount, is not in your budget, we offer the Tuition Partnership Program (TPP) (formally called Service Hours Program) wherein you can take advantage of the discounted rates noted on the document “2020-21 Tuition and Registration Rates.” WCA is an extension of the family in education, training, and discipline – a partnership! When students observe parents contributing their time and talents to the school, they know it is important and worthwhile. Conversely, the many wonderful talents and skills our parents bring to the table bless WCA considerably and help to keep tuition costs lower. In the partnership, parents contribute 15 hours (8 hours for 3-day Preschool families) of quality time to support the school in exchange for a **tuition credit of \$1500 per family**, as set forth in the “2020-21 Tuition and Registration Rates.”

## Program Details:

- Tuition Partnership hours for the 2020/21 academic year may commence on June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020 (You can complete next year’s hours during the summer Whitefish Art’s Festival!)
- The **deadline for completing Tuition Partnership hours is May 1, 2021**. To avoid charges on May 2, 2021, each parent is responsible to track volunteer hours on the Tuition Partnership Program Forms (located outside the office) and to submit them to Darlene Meehan.
- Hours not completed will be billed at a rate of \$100.00 per hour. These amounts are **not** generally tax deductible.
- Hours may not be “banked” and carried over to the following year
- Hours may be completed by extended family members (grandparents, aunts, uncles etc.) or a pre-designated friend of the family

Sign-up opportunities for specific events will be available on Back to School Night in August. TPP hour opportunities will be communicated in the WCA weekly newsletter and occasionally by email from the office staff. Ask teachers directly about classroom specific needs they may have.

Please strive to provide 15 quality hours, as you are being credited \$100 for each hour. If you have questions about what is a “quality” hour, please refer to the “Tuition Partnership Program -Volunteer Opportunities.”
